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The responsibility of the Ambulance cleaning is of the AMB drivers.

Sl. No	Activity	Remarks
1	Outside body to be cleaned with soap and water	As and when Ambulance gets dirty/After every trip/alternate day
2	Inside of the Ambulance- driver's area to be cleaned	Every alternate day/As and when necessary
3	Inside of the ambulance- patient area	Dry mopping daily; wet cleaning after every trip.
PROTOCOL		
4	Ambulance is driven unto the ramp	Maintaining a slope at the patient area.
5	All doors opened	Including drivers doors and windows
6	All surfaces are sprayed with water	Limited water is used so as not to deplete the natural resources
7	All surfaces scrubbed with So Klin ®	This is an antibacterial to kill microbes
8	Dry mopping done	To dry all areas and prevent rusting/smells
9	Ambulance is driven off the ramp after half an hour and then all doors opened to facilitate drying.
