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**GUIDELINES FOR NURSING CARE DURING PATIENT ADMISSION INTO WARD/ICU/LABOUR ROOM.**

Sl No.	Activity	Remarks
1	Receive the IPMC and patient from the reception	Portions of IPMC pertaining to SN are completed.
2	SN discusses with the reception and the treating doctor about the particulars with the patient.	This is done in the likely event that names/age has to be confirmed.
3	SN cross check the treating doctor the following	a) Orders b) Nursing procedures c) Consultations/References d) Drugs, dose, route, Brand names
4	Carry out the stat orders/and stat investigations.	This is carried out when specified.
5	Provide the hospital uniform to the patient. If patient is unable to change into the uniform, then the ward nurse helps the patient to do so.	This is done when the patient is being shifted to the OT/LABOUR ROOM/ICU, else in GRH there is no standard protocol for hospital uniform.
6	SN records the patient details in the admission & Discharge register.	
7	Blanket Consent of the patient is taken.	
8	Prepare the records in the in patient chart, as per the treating doctor's orders.	- Vital signs chart - Abdominal girth chart - Intake/Output chart - FHS chart - Diet chart - Drain tube chart
9	Educate patient and relatives.	Regarding visiting hours, diet to be provided, limiting the visitors, location of pharmacy. List of rules and regulations of GRH are given to the patient/by-standers and they acknowledge their acceptance by signing on it.
10	Online monitoring of the patient	As per PROTOCOL FOR IN PATIENT MAINTENANCE
