1	CNL	Examine the patient and confirm if patient cannot be handled at GRH/your facility	
		Inform MGR/PRO	
		Entry made into IPMC	
		Calls Higher Centre (e.g. IGMH/GRH) and discusses with the specialist on-call.	
		Manner of discussion	
		a) Patient Particulars	
		b) Present the case – when case arrived, on-arrival assessment	
		c) Investigations done	
		d) Treatment and progress along with relevant investigations is a chronological order	
		e) Working diagnosis	
		f) Reason for calling higher centre	
		Advice to be taken (write down while conversing)	
		a) Particulars of the consultant	
		b) Drugs to be administered	
		c) Oxygen to be given (yes/no)	
		d) Investigations to be done	
		e) Referral Necessary (yes/no)	
		f) Urgent/non-urgent referral	
		g) If patient can travel by flight/speed boat	
		h) If need of stretcher/splint/traction is needed.
